

# Fenton's CTE Course Offerings

#### **Business Education:**

<u>Accounting 1:</u> Open to students in grades 9-12. May be counted as Fourth Year Math credit (when taken as a senior).

Accounting 2: Prerequisite: Successful completion of Accounting 1 with a "B" or better. May be counted as Fourth Year Math credit (when taken as a senior).

BMA 1 (Business, Mgt. & Administration): Open to students in grades 9-12. The course covers major business concepts, such as Finance, Marketing, Operations, and Management.

<u>Finance</u>: Prerequisite: Successful completion of Business, Management & Administration 1 or permission from instructor. May be counted as Fourth Year Math credit (when taken as a senior).

<u>Virtual Enterprises International</u>: Prerequisite: Open to students in grades 10-12. Successful completion of BMA, Finance, or Accounting. May be taken as Fourth Year Math credit (when taken as a senior).

**Senior Project:** Prerequisite: Student must be a Senior with good attendance, good work ethic, recommendations, parent approval, own transportation, and a job related to a career choice.

### **Design & Technology:**

<u>CAD & Design Architectural 1:</u> Open to students in grades 9-12—qualifies for IB technology credit.

CAD & Design Architectural 2: Prerequisite: Successful completion of CAD & Design Architectural 1- qualifies for IB technology credit.

<u>CAD & Design Mechanical 1:</u> Open to students in grades 9-12—qualifies for IB technology credit.

<u>CAD & Design Mechanical 2</u>: Prerequisite: Successful completion of CAD & Design Mechanical 1—qualifies for IB technology credit.

#### Technology Support Development:

Open to students in grades 10-12. Students must apply to the instructor, demonstrating a technology interest and aptitude. This course serves as a prerequisite for student assistant in our computer labs.
